Have also had bus route 26 and 27 reinstated from Glascoed Way back to Pendine Way.

I run a Luncheon Club once a fortnight (school term) and arranged two day trips for members.

Have also organised well attended public meetings around planning applications.

Organised a meeting of local residents with local Police Inspector to discuss crime and anti social behaviour and a subsequent visit to the Police Control Room at St Asaph.

I have also attended several meetings with the Health Board and others to address issues around provision of primary care at Penymaes Surgery.
