- Feb 2018 - at the Homes and Environment Scrutiny committee I presented a report on the safety concerns of glyphosate based herbicide use. Information I had researched was presented to the committee and as a result of this information I believe we now have a far more rigorous Health and Safety system in place.

- May 2018 - organised a successful Recycle Action Day in the Cartrefle Ward.
- May 2018 - got my wellies on and replanted wildflower seeds in the Cartrefle wildflower verges (we have two). This was done with the help of my 10 year old daughter Tiya and Jonny from North Wales Wildlife Trust (see attached photos).
- Over the last year I have helped many people from the Cartrefle ward (and further afield) on everyday issues. My door is always open.
