CASE STUDIES

Sample of exclusion cases that have been subjected to a Fixed Term Exclusion in recent months. These cases have been selected at random and are from a variety of schools.

Primary

1. Year 6 - received a half day exclusion

Reason(s):

- a) Damage to classroom/ throwing chair across class.
- b) Refusal to follow instructions.

Context

- Complex case.
- Child already subject of Pastoral Support Plan and Child and Adolescent Mental Health Service (CAMHS) involved.
- SEN (Special Educational Needs) case at School Action Plus.
- Parent supportive of school action.

Secondary

1. Year 7 - 2 day exclusion

Reason(s):

a) Verbal Abuse Adult

Context

- 100% attendance.
- No previous exclusion.
- Subject of an Individual Education Plan.
- Awaiting Attention Deficit and Hyperactivity Disorder assessment.
- > Parent supportive.

2. Year 7 - 3 day exclusion

Reason(s):

a) Assault/Violence staff (threw a book at member of staff)

Context

- Access to Teaching Assistant and is a pupil with Special Educational Need (Autistic Spectrum Disorder)
- 90% attendance.
- Parent unhappy at outcome.

3. Year 8 – 5 day exclusion

Reason(s):

Assault on another pupil.

Context

- Narrative suggests lengthy defiance and verbal abuse to pupils and staff
- > 84% attendance and no Special Educational Needs
- 3 previous fixed term exclusions over past 12 months of 2 days, 5 days and 5 days. Parent accepts school decision

4. Year 10 – 4 day exclusion

Reason(s):

Persistent disruptive behaviour in supported class.

Context

- > 54% attendance.
- One previous exclusion for 10 days earlier in year under same category.
- Parents supportive of school and referral to school counsellor made.
- Included in Enrichment courses where the pupil engages well.

5. Year 11 – 10 day exclusion

Reason(s):

Verbal abuse adult.

Context

- Narrative suggests abusive language and defiance to Head Teacher
- 94 % attendance.
- Engages well in enrichment but Pastoral Support Plan noted as not having an impact in school.
- Parent supportive.
