I have carried out a consultation process of residents regarding request to expand the local playground for the young.

This is ongoing and will require grant funding if successful and this is being pursued through Caia Park Community Council with help from Wrexham County Borough Councils Parks Department.

I have been involved with the New Development on Rivulet Road that is managed now complete by Clwyd Alyn.

I have been involved with helping Pentre Gwyn Tan Y Coed and Coed Y Bryn successfully taking over the Lease of the Community Centre from ownership of Wrexham County Borough Council.

Thankfully this has been with the help also of Caia Park Community Council.

I attended the Caia Park Environmental Gardens Award where Gwenfro Community Primary School children got an award.

I was involved with the Environmental Department regarding the Kings Mills Sewerage overflow and flood of the area this was dealt with successfully.

I have attended meetings regarding local bus being withdrawn from the Kings Mills Road Abenbury Road area helping securing a 2 hourly bus service and I will continue to work with other local Councillor to improve the service if possible.

I continue to attend all member workshops to increase my knowledge and understanding on all matters particularly regarding the Budget Adult Social Care and Children's Social Care.
